SCHUMACHER/KETCHAM AWARD

Presentation of the Schumacher/Ketcham Lifesaver Award. This award honors Don Schumacher and Rick Ketcham for their long service to the OACDL and recognizes their significant contributions to the defense of indigent defendants facing the death penalty. Both of these men dedicated many hours in teaching the criminal defense community about the latest ideas and techniques. The OACDL created the Schumacher/Ketcham Lifesaver Award for Excellence in Death Penalty Litigation. This yearly award is designed to recognize outstanding achievements in avoiding imposition of the death penalty through trial excellence, mitigation investigation and presentation, as well as appellate and post conviction litigation, and education.
